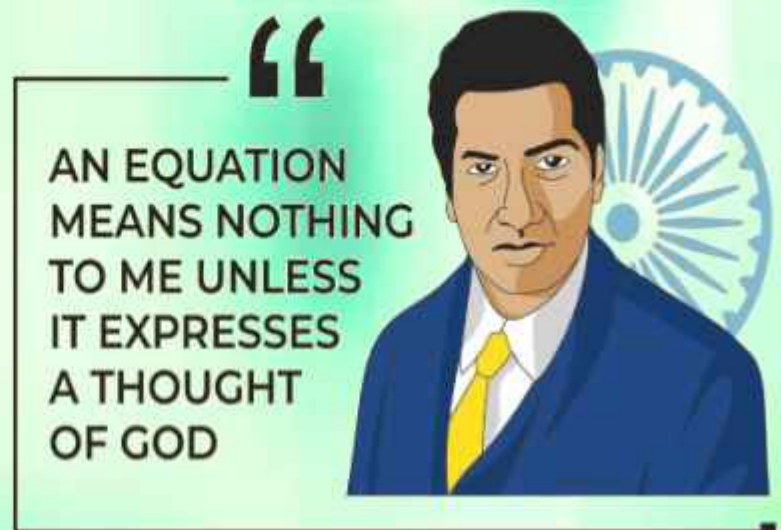


RAMANUJAN QUIZ - NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY

Subject: Tamil

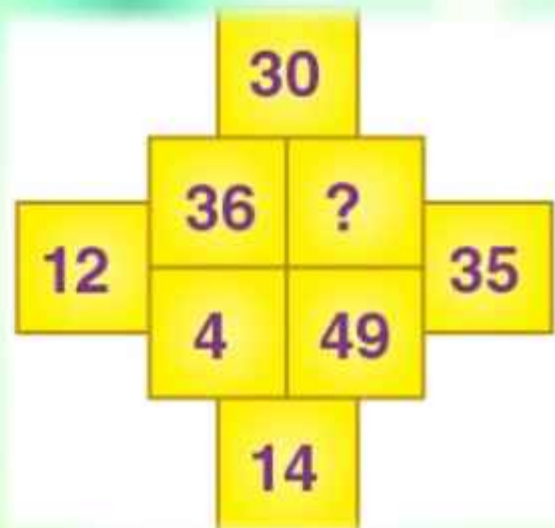
