Subject: Mathematics

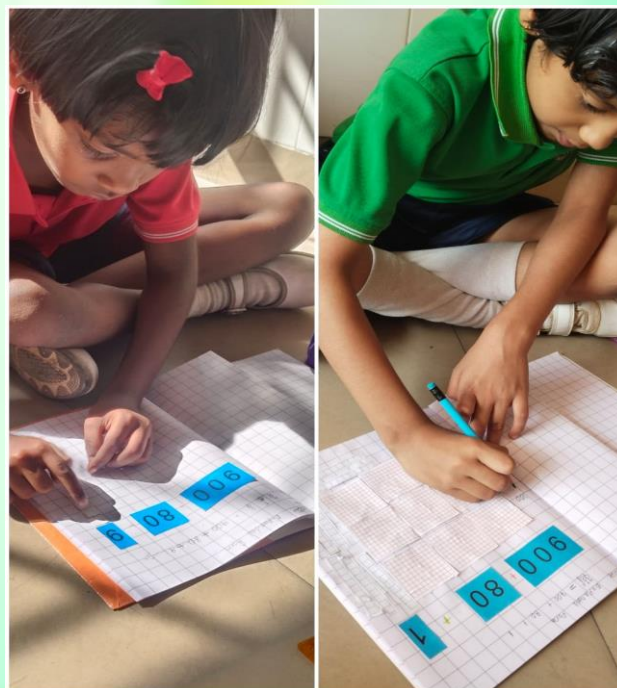
Arts subjects encourage self-expression and creativity and can build confidence as well as a sense of individual identity. Here our students of Grade - VI have Integrated Art with Place values.

Subject: Science

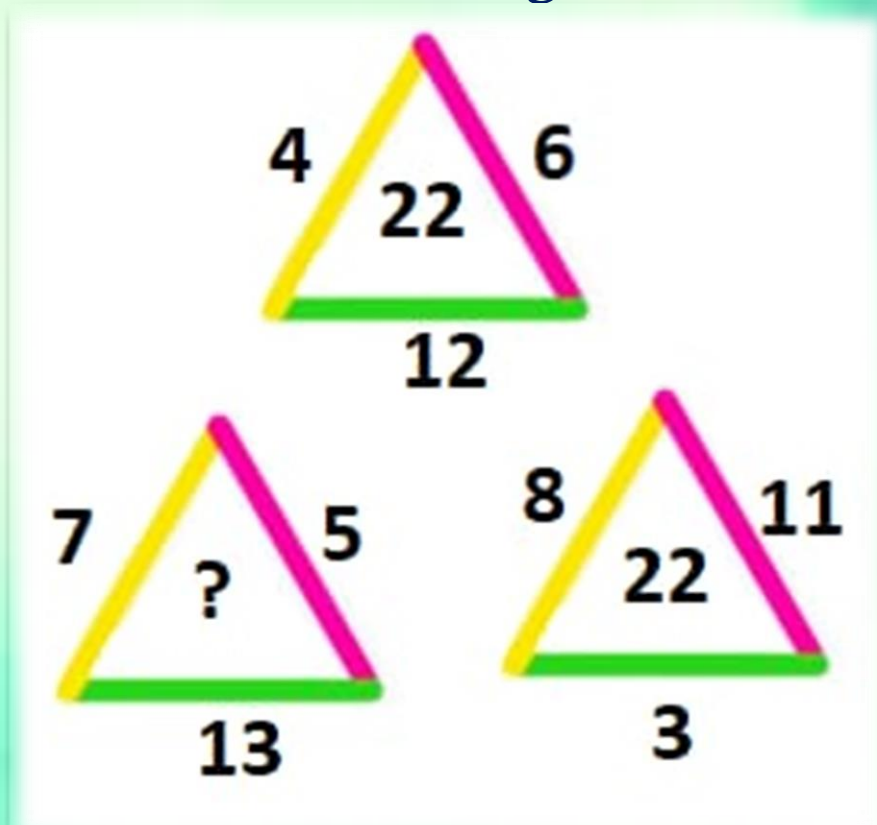

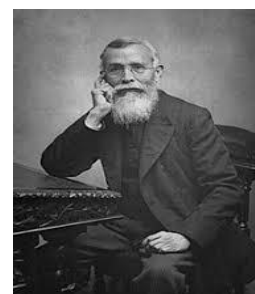
Dhadabai Naoroji

दादाभाई नौरोजी, जिन्हें अक्सर "भारत का ग्रैंड ओल्ड मैन" कहा जाता है, भारतीय राष्ट्रवादी आंदोलन में एक महान व्यक्ति थे। उन्होंने अपना जीवन भारतीय स्वतंत्रता और सामाजिक सुधार की वकालत के लिए समर्पित कर दिया। उनके सबसे महत्वपूर्ण योगदानों में से एक अंग्रेजों द्वारा भारत के आर्थिक शोषण पर उनका अग्रणी काम था। नौरोजी भारत से धन की निकासी को उजागर करने वाली शुरुआती आवाजों में से एक थे, उन्होंने इस बात पर जोर दिया कि कैसे औपनिवेशिक नीतियों ने भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्था और इसके लोगों को गरीब बना दिया।

ब्रिटिश उपनिवेशवाद द्वारा प्रेरित आर्थिक शोषण को उजागर करने के उनके अथक प्रयासों ने नौरोजी को भारतीय स्वतंत्रता की लड़ाई में एक प्रमुख नेता बना दिया। उन्होंने ब्रिटिश संसद में भारतीय प्रतिनिधित्व के लिए अथक अभियान चलाया और भारत की आर्थिक भलाई पर ब्रिटिश नीतियों के हानिकारक प्रभाव के बारे में जागरूकता बढ़ाने के लिए अथक प्रयास किया। नौरोजी की वकालत ने स्वतंत्रता आंदोलन के भावी नेताओं के लिए आधार तैयार किया और यह भारत की स्वतंत्रता के प्रति उनकी अटूट प्रतिबद्धता का प्रमाण है।

Dadabhai Naoroji, often referred to as the "Grand Old Man of India," was a towering figure in the Indian nationalist movement. He dedicated his life to advocate for Indian independence and social reform. One of his most significant contributions was his pioneering work on the economic exploitation of India by the British. Naoroji was one among the earliest voices to highlight the drain of wealth from India, emphasizing how colonial policies impoverished the Indian economy and its people.

His relentless efforts to expose the economic exploitation fuelled by British colonialism made Naoroji a prominent leader in the fight for Indian independence. He tirelessly campaigned for Indian representation in the British Parliament and tirelessly worked to raise awareness about the detrimental impact of British policies on India's economic well-being. Naoroji's advocacy laid the groundwork for future leaders of the independence movement and remains a testament to his unwavering commitment to the cause of India's freedom.
