ನಾಗಮ್ಮ ಪಾಟೀಲ

ಭಾರತದ ಸ್ವಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯ ಹೋರಾಟದ ನಡುವೆ, ಪಾಟೀಲರು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದಲ್ಲಿ ಗಾಂಧಿ ಚಳುವಳಿಯ ಸಂಕೇತವಾದರು. ಭಾರತವು ತನ್ನ ಸ್ವಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯವನ್ನು ಸಾಧಿಸಿದ ನಂತರ, ಅವರು ಮಕ್ಕಳಿಗೆ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣ ನೀಡಲು ತನ್ನನ್ನು ತೊಡಗಿಸಿಕೊಂಡರು. ಡಿಸೆಂಬರ್ 16, 1905 ರಂದು ಜನಿಸಿದ ಅವರು ಹಿರಿಯ ಸ್ವಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯ ಹೋರಾಟಗಾರ ಪದ್ಮಶ್ರೀ ಸರ್ದಾರ್ ವೀರನಗೌಡ ಪಾಟೀಲ್ ಅವರನ್ನು ವಿವಾಹವಾದರು .1924 ರಲ್ಲಿ, ಮಹಾತ್ಮಾ ಗಾಂಧಿ ಬೆಳಗಾವಿಗೆ ಭೇಟಿ ನೀಡಿದಾಗ, ಅದು ಅವರ ಆಳವಾದ ಪ್ರಭಾವವನ್ನು ಬೀರಿತು ಮತ್ತು ಅವರು ಗಾಂಧಿಯವರ ಕಟ್ಟಾ ಅನುಯಾಯಿಯಾದರು. 1930 ರ ದಶಕದಲ್ಲಿ, ಅವರು ಸರ್ದಾರ್ ವೀರನಗೌಡ ಅವರನ್ನು ಸೇರಿಕೊಂಡರು ಮತ್ತು ಹುಬ್ಬಳ್ಳಿಯ ಹರಿಜನ ಬಾಲಿಕಾ ಆಶ್ರಮವನ್ನು ಸ್ಥಾಪಿಸಿದರು.ನಾಗಮ್ಮ ಮತ್ತು ಅವರ ಪತಿ ಇಬ್ಬರೂ 1938 ರಲ್ಲಿ ಸ್ವಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯ ಹೋರಾಟಕ್ಕೆ ಮಹಾತ್ಮ ಗಾಂಧಿಯವರ ಹೋರಾಟದ ಕರೆಯನ್ನು ಕೇಳಿದರು. ಅದೇ ವರ್ಷ ಬೆಳಗಾವಿಯ ಹಿಂಡಲಗಾ ಜೈಲಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಮೂರು ತಿಂಗಳ ಕಾಲ ಆಕೆಯನ್ನು ಬಂಧಿಸಲಾಯಿತು. 1942 ರಲ್ಲಿ, ಆಕೆಯನ್ನು 13 ತಿಂಗಳ ಕಾಲ ಯರವಾಡ ಸೆಂಟ್ರಲ್ ನಲ್ಲಿ ಬಂಧಿಸಲಾಯಿತು.

Nagamma Patil

Amid India's freedom struggle, Patil became a symbol of the Gandhian movement in Karnataka. After India achieved its independence, she devoted herself to educating children. Born on December 16, 1905, she married veteran freedom fighter Padma Shri Sardar Veerana Gowda Patil.

In 1924, when Mahatma Gandhi visited Belgaum, it made a deep impression on him and he became a staunch follower of Gandhi. In the 1930s, she joined Sardar Veerana Gowda and founded the Harijan Balika Ashram in Hubli. Both Nagamma and her husband heard Mahatma Gandhi's call to freedom struggle in 1938. In the same year, she was detained in Hindalaga Jail in Belgaum for three months. In 1942, She was detained at Yerawada Central for 13 months. She was instrumental in encouraging women to attend the historic Belgaum session of Congress presided by Gandhi.
